

# COVID-19 HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS

## Require Visitors to follow our Robust Health Policy



Prior to visiting the place of worship, all church attendees are asked to carefully review our health policy, which requires all church attendees to have been healthy for at least 14 days prior to their visit.

## Disinfect High Touch Areas Frequently



We are significantly increasing our efforts to sanitize and disinfect all high touch points, such as chairs, doors, offering boxes, etc.

## Continuously Clean & Sanitize



Our cleaning team will be cleaning and sanitizing the entire facility before & after each service according to DCD guidelines.

## Controlled Hall Capacities & Guest Separation in Seating



We will strictly enforce reduced hall capacities. Seats will be removed from each hall to ensure there is at least a 2 meter gap between each individual attending the place of worship.

## Check the Temperature of Facility Staff



All Facility Staff will be screened for high temperatures when they arrive at the building and at regular intervals throughout the day.

## Only MH1 & MH2 Open



All facility floors, rooms, & restrooms will remain closed with the exception of Main Hall 1 & Main Hall 2 until further notice.

### ALHOSN UAE App is Required



All church attendees & facility staff will be required to have the ALHOSN UAE app on their phone. Download the app here: <https://www.ncema.gov.ae/alhosn/index.html>

### Masks & Gloves are Required at All Times



All church attendees and facility staff will be required to wear face masks covering the nose and mouth as well as gloves throughout their time at the facility.

### Conduct Non-Invasive Temperature Checks



We will be using state-of-the-art thermal scanners to check the temperature of all church attendees prior to entering the facility.

### Promote 2 Meter Separation in all Queues & Halls



We have floor markers & queue lines all throughout the place of worship to help guests keep a 2 meter distance from one another.

### No Physical Contact



Church attendees should avoid shaking hands, hugging, kissing, etc. while at the facility.

### Hand Sanitizer Stations Throughout the Facility



We have a large number of hands free sanitizer stations throughout the facility offering free hand sanitizer to church attendees and staff.

### Do Not Come if You are Sick



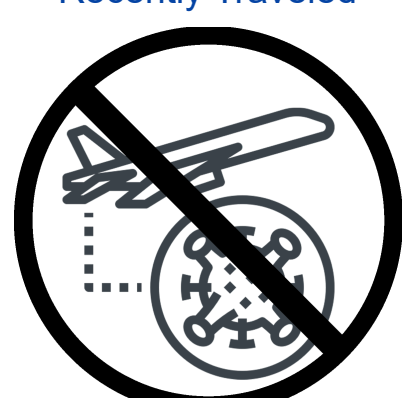
If you or anyone you have been in close proximity to are sick or have exhibited any Covid-19 symptoms in the past 14 days, please do not come to the facility.

### Do Not Come if You are at Risk



If you are 60 or older, 12 or younger, pregnant, or if Covid-19 poses a higher risk to you due to pre-existing health conditions, please do not come to the facility.

### Do Not Come if You have Recently Traveled



If you or someone you have been in close proximity to have recently traveled, please self quarantine for at least 14 days prior to visiting the facility.
